- (2) The Sheboygan County Health and Human Services Department (through its Aging and Disability Resource Center) applied for and received Section 5310 funding to expand its volunteer driver program. This expansion will provide additional rides to those who need an accessible vehicle, people with disabilities, and for trip purposes other than just medically-related appointments. This expanded volunteer driver program is being assigned the same TIP identification number as the original volunteer driver program.
