

PLANNER II

Job Summary:

The Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission (Bay-Lake RPC) is seeking a Planner II to complement its professional staff. The Planner II will work with the Bay-Lake RPC staff, counties, municipalities, and state and federal partner agencies in a variety of planning programs. Time will be spent primarily working within Bay-Lake RPC's community assistance program, with shared time in transportation, economic development, and environmental programs; data research; and general planning support. The Planner II is a mid-to-senior level position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- The ideal candidate will have experience in leading projects, report preparation, superior written and verbal skills, familiarity with common demographic and economic research and analysis, grant writing and project administration; and has the ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Leads/assists with the development and implementation of local and regional planning efforts including, but not limited to; comprehensive plans, hazard mitigation planning, outdoor recreation plans, ordinances, and other land use plans and studies as needed.
- Duties will be performed under the general direction of the Assistant Director and Executive Director.

Education and Experience:

The successful candidate requires a bachelor's degree in urban/regional planning or a related field from an accredited college or university; master's degrees preferred. Two or more years of progressively responsible planning experience will be highly valued. A proven combination of experience and training that ensures the ability to perform the work is expected.

Necessary Knowledge, Abilities, and Skills:

- Working knowledge of the principles and practices of planning; knowledge of federal and state planning programs and appropriate regulations and guidelines.
- Ability to manage various types of planning projects with limited supervision and follow them through to successful completion on a specific timeline. This includes project financial management and contract compliance.
- Comfortable working directly with local units of governments, groups, and individuals, as well as speaking in public.
- Ability to oversee multiple projects simultaneously, work well under pressure, and handle stressful situations.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Professional programs (Word, Excel, and Outlook) is required.
- Experience with Adobe Creative Suite (InDesign, Illustrator, and Photoshop) is preferred, and Sketchup and GIS is desirable.

Compensation & Benefits:

\$62,209 - \$76,183 annually, with a 12-month probationary period upon starting. The starting salary is negotiable based on level of experience. Benefits package includes health, dental, vision, life, and disability insurance; paid holidays, vacation, sick leave, and participation in the Wisconsin State Retirement System.

Located in the Green Bay metro area, the Bay-Lake RPC offers a range of planning services to member counties and municipalities.
