Population decreased by 1,618 over the last 5 years and is projected to decrease by 871 over the next 5 years.

Jobs grew by 139 over the last 5 years and are projected to grow by 85 over the next 5 years.

Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 2.0%** since 2013, falling by 1,618. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.1%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 871.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 0.4% in Manitowoc County, WI from 37,222 to 37,361. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 7.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.9% to 61.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.6% of Manitowoc County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.0% below the national average), and **10.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Animal Production.







Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Manitowoc County, WI had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 3.73%, decreasing from 6.04% 5 years before.






Millennials

Manitowoc County, WI has 12,585 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 16,398.




Veterans

Manitowoc County, WI has 5,384 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4,604.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Manitowoc County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,571 people 55 or older, while there are 28,682 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Manitowoc County, WI has 18.7 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP



Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 1,197 graduates in Manitowoc County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 3% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide, Licensed Practical/Vocational Nurse Training, and Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse.
