2026 *Community Project Survey*

OF THE BAY-LAKE REGION

Why should my community submit the survey?

Filling out the Community Project Survey informs the Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission about future projects in your community. Responses will be reviewed to identify potential federal and state funding opportunities and determine how the Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission may be able to assist.

Who should fill out the survey?

The survey may be completed by any representative familiar with your community's planned projects and priorities.

Your community may submit multiple survey responses. We encourage individual departments to complete their own submission to ensure that the priorities and projects of each department are accurately represented.

What types of projects should be included?

You may list any projects your community hopes to pursue within the next one to three years. Projects can include physical infrastructure, community development, or planning initiatives. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Planning efforts (comprehensive plans, hazard mitigation plans, outdoor recreation plans, capital improvement plans, housing studies)
- Business or industrial park development
- Downtown or brownfield redevelopment, placemaking, etc.
- Road, bridge, bike/ped, and other transportation improvements
- Public safety facilities (fire stations, EMS, police)
- Environmental conservation or restoration
- Sanitary sewer, stormwater, and water infrastructure improvements
- Park and trail development or upgrades
- Community centers, libraries, and other public buildings
- Workforce development or training facilities

How do I submit the survey?
